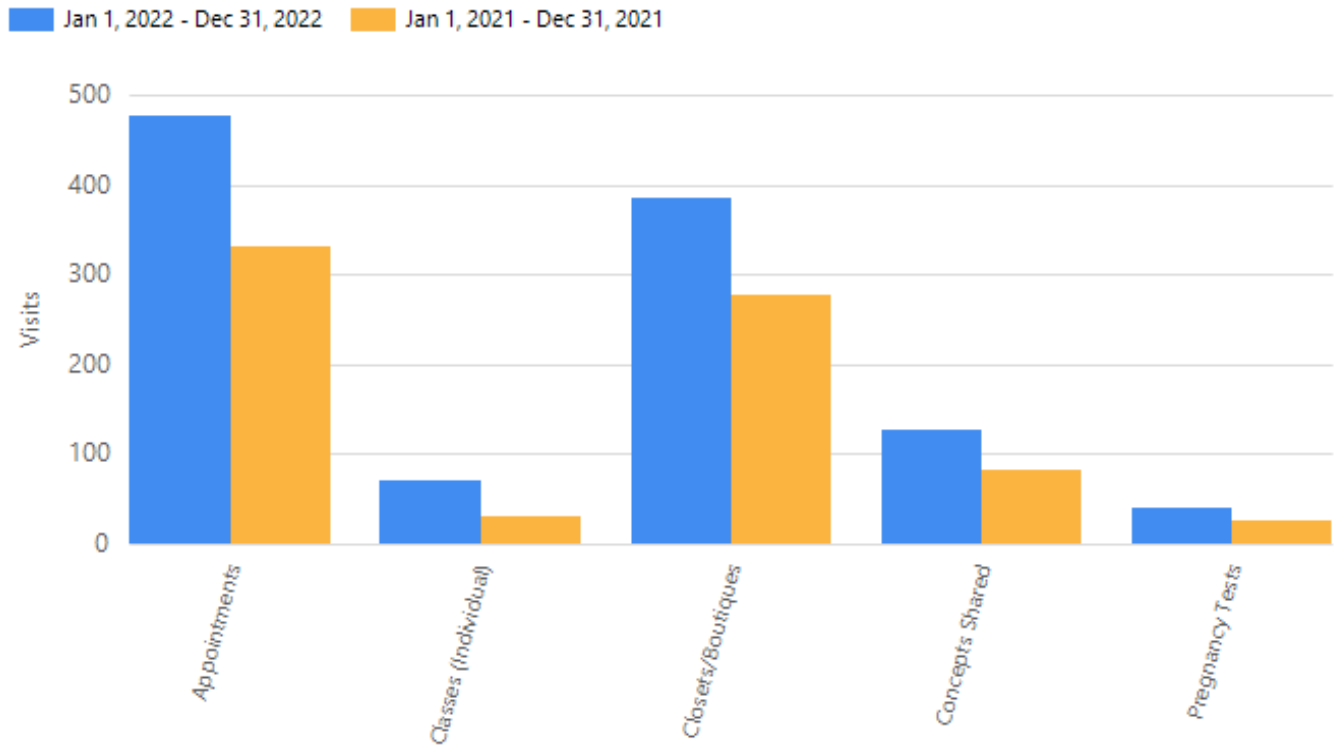

## Hope Women's Center Core Values

- 1 The Gospel of Jesus Christ** The love of Christ compels us to honor and follow him as our LORD in word and deed; to encourage, admonish, and love one another, openly expressing our faith in the workplace, and to be a faithful witness to our neighbors, freely sharing the gospel message of repentance, reconciliation with God, and new spiritual life through Jesus. - 2 Dependence on God** Aware that we are called by God to work in service that we cannot accomplish successfully on our own, we eagerly express our dependence on God through prayer, fasting, meditation on Scripture, assembly of the Saints, and other acts of worship. - 3 High View of Human Sexuality** We affirm and promote God's call to sexual integrity for all people. Recognizing that sexual intimacy is designed for enjoyment only within biblical marriage between one biological man and one biological woman, we also promote healing and restoration where people have experienced sexuality in broken ways. Faithful, healthy, loving marriage remains the ideal context for nurturing children physically, emotionally, and socially; further, Christian covenantal marriage provides the best foundation for training children spiritually so that they will have the abundant life that God intends. Each human life is a gift from God, worthy of respect from conception until natural death, without regard to perceived ability, quality of life, or factors beyond basic humanity. (*Genesis 1:27; Psalm 139:13-16; Psalm 127:3; Luke 1:41*)
- 5 Integrity** All of our dealings are honest, ethical, and transparent. We value integrity, humility, authenticity, and responsible stewardship in our relationships with employees, volunteers, supporters, service recipients, and the public. (*Micah 6:8; Romans 12:10; Matthew 5:16; Proverbs 11:3; Titus 2:7-8; Colossians 3:23-24*)

## Looking Forward to an Abundant 2023!

As exciting as 2022 was we are expecting great things to happen in 2023. As most of you know, last year we introduced our 3-to-5-year strategic plan to work toward getting ultrasound. We anticipated getting our attic finished, being able to use it for storage to free up a room for the ultrasound. However, we found that finishing the attic would not be feasible.

Also, we learned by adding ultrasound we would be considered a medical facility. With that comes more upgrades and legalities to be considered. Below is a list of steps to be completed before getting an ultrasound and becoming medical.

- Climate controlled building for storage
- Fix water drainage issues
- Medical Director on the board
- Sufficient driveway and parking area for safety
- Improve our handicap ramp
- ADA compliant doors
- Upgrade the pregnancy test restroom
- Add a handicap accessible restroom for ultrasound room
- Join National Institute of Family and Life Advocates (NIFLA) – for legal counseling
- Malpractice insurance
- Nurse – Certified to do ultrasounds
- Education and training for staff and volunteers
