On Going Needs

Hope Women's Center tries to provide anything a baby up to the age of 24 months might need. As with any "family" our stock frequently needs to be replaced and often our needs vary.

Right now we need diapers in sizes New Born, 4,5, and 6. We need to replenish our supply of Boys clothes sizes 12-24 months and Girls sizes 18-24 months. We could also use larger size socks (we have lots of small ones).

We need Gerber Good Start, Sooth and Gentle formula (Please check the expiration dates). We always have a need for soap, shampoo, lotion, and other baby toiletries. Thank you ever so much for your consideration of these needs.

SC Heartbeat Bill

Please tell our state leaders and your fellow South Carolinians that you believe life in our state should be protected by passing the Heartbeat Bill H3020.

Last year alone, almost 6,000 babies were aborted in South Carolina. That means thousands of precious humans never had the fundamental opportunity to experience life.

We believe that number should be zero in

South Carolina, but to make that happen we need your help!

During the 2018 legislative session, the Heartbeat Bill was passed by the South Carolina House of Representatives before stalling in the Senate. But now, in an unlikely move, the Senate Medical Affairs Committee has decided to take up the bill this summer instead of waiting until the next session set to begin in January.

On September 10, the committee will have a hearing and hold a vote to recommend the bill to the full senate.

Please let your Senator know if you believe the Senate Medical Affairs Committee should protect life in South Carolina by voting in favor of the South Carolina Heartbeat Bill.

The bill H3020 passed by the House in April would outlaw most abortions once a fetal heartbeat can be detected, roughly in the sixth week of pregnancy, before some women know they are pregnant. However, the legislation included exceptions for victims of rape and incest.

Despite opposition from critics like Planned Parenthood, who have called the bill "extreme" and "deeply disappointing," Governor McMaster again vowed to sign the bill once it lands on his desk.

"The right to life is fundamental to everything we stand for," McMaster said. "It's time for the Senate to listen to the people of South Carolina, who everyone in this building works directly for."
