## What does the Bible say about the unborn?

The Bible is far from silent on the topic of the sanctity of human life, especially preborn life in the womb.

"Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, And He who formed you from the womb: "I *am* the LORD, who makes all *things*, Who stretches out the heavens all alone, Who spreads abroad the earth by Myself;" (Isaiah 44:24, NKJV)

"For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb." (Psalms 139:13, NKJV)

"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; Before you were born I sanctified<sup>[a]</sup> you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations." (Jeremiah 1:5, NKJV)

"But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb and called *me* through His grace," (Galatians 1:15, NKJV)

"And it happened, when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, that the babe leaped in her womb; and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit." (Luke 1:41, NKJV)

The Lord Jesus Christ began his incarnation as an embryo, growing into a fetus, infant, child, teenager and adult.

"So it was, that while they were there, the days were completed for her to be delivered. And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn." (Luke 2:6 - 7, NKJV)
